The Best Yet!

The Sydney AOS auction has become one of our most prestigious presentations of the year. This year it will be bigger and better yet again.

This year we are presenting 13 ridden horses with a couple of magnificent 3-year-olds who will bring the house down. Of course there is a balance of some more experienced horses who have already started their competition careers and who traditionally demand a lot of interest. Also there is one young thoroughbred in amongst the beautifully bred warmbloods. The thoroughbred's name is Benauring, and this individual is showing signs of being a very nice dressage horse as well as having spectacular talents over the showjumps and the cross-country fences. This is exactly the sort of horse that Australia used to win three consecutive Olympic team gold medals in the three-day event discipline in Barcelona Spain 1992, Atlanta USA 1996 and Sydney Australia in 2000.

And then of course we have 16 purpose-bred unbroken youngsters that are genetically designed to be state-of-the-art material in Australia's quest for future gold medals in the Olympic disciplines in years to come.

In years gone by, Australians have had to journey to the Northern Hemisphere before they could purchase state-of-the-art young warmblood stock focused up on the Olympic disciplines. This phenomenon has pretty well turned a full circle and today the Australian breeders are able to access, through imported stallions and frozen semen, the best genetics in existence in the world. Furthermore Australia does have space and paddocks and a wonderful climate and fertile soils, which have all contributed to the Australian breeding program progressing rapidly until now, where the inevitable has happened and today we produce young stock equivalent to the best from any other country. The upside on this is huge.

Whatever you pay for a youngster here in Australia, it will be much cheaper and better value for money than anything you can buy in the Northern Hemisphere. Once a youngster has been bought in the Northern Hemisphere, to transport a horse to Australia and pay quarantine costs will come to not less than \$25,000. Add this on top of the purchase price and you are now talking about a very expensive exercise.

FOREWORD

Conversely, the unbroken youngsters in this catalogue do represent the best bloodlines available in Europe and even the most expensive one will be less than the quarantine and transport costs involved with bringing a Northern Hemisphere baby in to Australia.

Perhaps the other really interesting consideration is that the top-of-the-range 3yos and 4yos in Europe can demand spectacular prices and so there is a European culture of horse dealing and the dealers continuously search out all likely youngsters, assessing them and then purchasing what they think are the best, with a view to marketing to wealthy international buyers. In other words, it is very difficult to find young horses in Europe that have not already been very carefully assessed by very astute horse people.

What we Australians see when searching through Europe for a young horse is inclined to be the damaged and the lesser youngsters left after the big dealers have had first look. Just keep in mind that in Germany the horse industry is only second to the automobile industry. Certainly the horse industry is a very well-oiled and slick process in countries like Holland and Germany.

The Auction of the Stars is a collection of young horses straight off the paddocks here in Australia and this presentation is the first scrutinising that most of these youngsters have ever had by prospective buyers. They are top-of-the-range horses and you are the first people to see them prepared and presented for your assessment and purchase. Finally, we also present 3 broodmares, which are state-of-the-art genetic banks in foal to stallions carrying some of the best bloodlines in the world. These mares are always sold with a live foal guarantee and always create a lot of interest amongst the Australian buyers.

Ladies and gentlemen, we wish everyone a lot of luck and look forward to following the adventures and successes of these horses and their new owners in the future.

DIRECTIONS

An easy 50-minute drive from the Sydney CBD. From Sydney take the M2 Motorway; this continues to become the Westlink M7. Take the Richmond/Blacktown Road exit and continue straight ahead to Richmond. At the intersection of Bourke Street, Blacktown Road becomes Lennox Street. Follow Lennox Street till you get to the intersection with East Market Street; turn right into East Market Street. At the intersection of East Market Street and Windsor Street turn left. This is the main road in Richmond and it turns into Old Kurrajong Road as it leaves town. Follow this road for about 1km, until the sweeping bend with a road on the right, this is Ridges Lane. Turn right on to Ridges Lane and go straight ahead until you see the sandstone and wrought iron gates of the Sydney Polo Club.

Ridden Horse Trialling



This is one of the outstanding opportunities offered through the AOS selling program. We would encourage all riders who are slightly interested in the ridden horses to pluck up the courage to trial these horses in the official trialling times. Of course you are very welcome to trial these horses by prior arrangement in the weeks preceding the auction. Most people do suffer from the thought of riding in front of a crowd on the official trialling day. Our take on this is that if you are too embarrassed to look out for your own interests, then certainly nobody else will. Also if you have dreams and ambitions secret or otherwise, and being embarrassed is the biggest obstacle you have to overcome, then really life is not too bad. Realistically you will have to overcome much bigger obstacles than just being self-conscious or embarrassed. Get out there, trial these horses and take advantage of a great opportunity.

At the auction you do have the very unique advantage of comparing one horse against the other. This comparison opportunity is exactly what happens in competition, one horse immediately compared against another, a phenomena which is very difficult to replicate when buying a horse privately. Riding is a passion discipline and in most instances when buying privately a prospective purchaser falls in love with a horse and buys it. In the auction situation, a prospective purchaser is much more likely to weigh up the pros and cons of each horse on a comparative basis. Of course, falling in love with the horse is a critical ingredient for success but we at the AOS would encourage you firstly to select your next horse on an intellectual level, and then follow your heart and fall in love with the horse. We all know of people that have bought horses that didn't turn out to be everything they had hoped for but nevertheless, love the horse and persevere even when it is clear they should sell and start again. Treat the auction trialling as a day at the office.

We encourage everyone to trial each horse that goes close to falling into their wish list category. Keep in mind that sometimes a horse that reads and looks mediocre in the catalogue actually turns out to be lots, lots better in real life than you had expected. Conversely some horses will catch your imagination in the catalogue, and then be disappointing in real life. Once you ride more than 2 horses you will lose track of details on each horse so we would encourage you to write notes on each horse immediately after trialling them. Also, watching a horse being trialled by other riders is a great way of assessing honesty and rideability.

The first official trialling is at 1.30pm on Saturday June 2 and we would encourage all interested parties to take advantage of this Saturday trialling. This does give you as the potential buyer the opportunity to have another ride the next day Sunday June 3 at 8am. This also gives you enough time to research the horses and talk to the owners.

The basic format of trialling is that 3 horses come into the arena and are shown off for the first 5 minutes by their vendors, basically warming up and just gently running through the horse's routine. Then people wishing to have a little sit are invited to come forward. Prospective buyers organise to trial a horse by approaching the AOS representative, who takes a list of names so as to keep the trialling ordered and also signing the appropriate waivers. Each trialling is tailored to each rider's individual needs, keeping in mind that the first and foremost priority is safety, and of course the well-being of the horse. It is a very hectic schedule with two sessions of public trialling plus the auction, all in two days, so horse welfare is a major consideration. We are of course very aware of also servicing the rider's needs.

Fiji R is an exciting young imported stallion campaigned and trained by young rider Breanna Tilitzki. Breanna has had great success with Fiji R, winning with scores over 75%. These scores have been posted at major competitions including Sydney competitions. Fiji R has now started competing at medium and advanced levels, again posting big scores in the high 60s and low 70%. This in itself is quite a phenomenon! Fiji R has the quietest of temperaments which he passes on to his foals and makes him an absolute delight at competitions. Fiji R has quite remarkable paces with a very distinctive walk. Trot is fully suspended with a definite ballerina poise between beats. Canter is beautifully balanced and uphill with super easy flying changes. Florencio I is by Florestan I who has emerged as one of the recent very important dressage lines in Germany and who has a number of Olympic offspring to his credit already. The Hill Hawke line has become famous as a dam line by also being the dam line of the Welt Hit line. Starnberg is a light, elegant, modern warmblood and has the most beautiful conformation. The Starnberg foals are creating a real stir and seem to be inheriting their fathers beautiful temperament and extraordinary good looks. Starnberg himself has massive overtrack in his walk, a truly exciting trot that shows talent for collection and indeed piaffe steps, and an explosive natural affinity with expansive passage and extensions. The canter is beautifully balanced and light. When ridden quietly the canter is a ladies' delight being super collected, extremely comfortable and ever-so-light in the hand. However, when ridden energetically in a competition production Starnberg comes alive with very expressive front leg action and great hock action all being presented in a beautiful round outline with the steadiest of head carriage. Starnberg's flying changes are a party trick and even at this very young age he is already showing incredible one-time changes. Starnberg is already winning and placing at advanced level dressage.






