AUCTION HORSES WINNING

Auction of the Stars has always boasted its potential to impact on Olympic performances and be part of fulfilling the dreams of riders who are part of the equestrian world, whether those dreams have been mighty or more modest.



To date I have avoided pointing out that many of the horses having gone through the auction are indeed stepping up to the plate and doing us proud. Just gone for us is the Sydney CDI on May 4/5 2013 which is the most prestigious International dressage show in Australia.

Utopia Cardinal had his first International Grand Prix start and in actual fact it was his third only Grand Prix start ever. Cardinal did a great test and scored 66.149% in 6th place which was just behind his father Regardez Moi. Interesting to note the International judges had him on 67% and 68%, which had Cardinal challenging for 2nd place amongst the best horses in Australia at the moment. Cardinal did, however, win the Intermediare II class. Keep in mind that Cardinal is only 8 years of age. Cardinal like many of the horses in the auction is by Regardez Moi. Cardinal did go through the AOS auction in 2010 when he was a 6yo and could have been secured for \$70,000. He is owned by Anthony & Jules Thornhill and we think he has a value of about \$600,000. Once Cardinal goes through the 70% mark in international Grand Prix, a fairly standard benchmark for this kind of performance is more than \$1million.

In the USA is Grand Prix dressage horse Jeff the Chef W, sold as a weanling at AOS Melbourne and is being ridden by Michael Barisone. We are hoping that this horse will appear on the American team for the coming World Equestrian Games in Normandy, France.

Again in the Melbourne auction in 2011 we sold a young jumping horse on behalf of Russell Johnstone called Chesterfield. In only his second ever official competition under the name Joié du Lys on March 23/24 at Wandin CIC Horse Trials, this horse won the 4 & 5yo Young Event Horse Championship. This prestigious class is the eventing equivalent of Dressage and Jumping with the Stars and has been won by horses that have gone onto international careers such as Darien Powers and Kirby Park Irish Hallmark. A hotly contested class of predominately professionally ridden horses, Joié du Lys won convincingly with owner/rider Callum Buczak.

The auctions do give buyers the opportunity to access amazing performance bloodlines. Richmeed Medallion is a stallion who features in much of the breeding and he of course was the sire of Mystery Whisper who represented the USA at the 2012 Olympics with Phillip Dutton in the saddle. Rosa Cha has gone Grand Prix in the USA and is by Regardez Moi. In the Young Horse class at Dressage with the Stars in March this year the winner of the 6yo class was Jazzski, by the AOS stallion Jive Magic.

Of course Auction of the Stars does have a lot of representation of the Salute blood, probably the most influential line in Australia at the moment of top competition horses. Salute is the sire of: Victory Salute, 9th in the world at WEG 2010 and represented Australia at the 2010 World Cup Final at s'Hertogenbosch in Holland with Brett Parbery; Stirling Stilton, Australia representative at WEG 2002 in Spain and was the highest-scoring member of the Australian team with Olympian Heath Ryan; DP Christopher, NSW Grand Prix Champion some years ago; Stirling Sprite, advanced eventer and World Cup showjumper with Olympian Vicki Roycroft; Staccato, previously ranked number one eventing stallion in the world with Craig Barrett; Stirling Soux, 4-star eventer with Olympian Olivia Bunn; F1 Pharenelli, 4-star eventer with Emma Mason; Sydney Lights, 3-star eventer with Heath Ryan; Salute was also the sire of the dam of Mystery Whisper who competed at the London Olympics in 2012. Of the above Salute performers, Stirling Stilton, Stirling Sprite, Stirling Soux and F1 Pharenelli all sold through our auctions. Of course there are lots of horses that have been also similarly successful in terms of partnering owners in their own journeys, which are perhaps are not quite so high profile. Of course this is just as important.

I think the point I would like to make is that if you purchase a horse through the AOS you really and truly are sorting through a group of horses that represent greater opportunities than perhaps any other collection of horses being presented for sale anywhere else in Australia. Good luck - and I hope you too can find a soul mate at our Sydney AOS on 30 June.

A MESSAGE FROM ANN-MAREE

A HORSE FOR EVERYONE

Some seventeen years ago, I was seized with the idea of buying a Richmeed Medallion foal to safeguard my competition future. The little black imported stallion had his second crop of foals on the ground, and I was determined to keep up with the improving gene pools of Australia and have one for myself.



I nagged Heath Ryan until he walked down to the mare and foal paddock with me, and together we eyed the foals. Heath pointed out the Medallion foals, then specifically the Medallion colts.

'I want THAT one,' I pointed, having made up my mind about what I thought was the best-looking colt. Heath told me it wasn't his to sell and that it was too expensive for my budget anyway. We again surveyed the Medallion colts.

'Then I'll have THAT one,' I pointed again at a little colt with a cute face. Then began the haggling over his price, but that's another story!

The colt ultimately became Grand Prix horse number three for me. And where is the one I couldn't afford? It certainly didn't end up in the competition arena. Missing out on it certainly didn't mean that I didn't get where I wanted to go. Where are all the other Medallion offspring born that year in that paddock? They didn't appear anywhere in competition, but undoubtedly gave their owners great joy and satisfaction.

The point is, the foals in the group were ALL bred to do what I wanted to do. It was the luck of the draw whether they were bought by a competition rider or by a pleasure rider, or by someone who mixed the two. Maybe they were bought by someone with a dream, who never made it come true because life got in the way. But it really didn't matter which one I bought, and the proof was Byalee Magic, a champion Grand Prix horse.

It is the same here at this auction. All of the youngsters here are bred to do the job. If you miss out on Lot 7, for example, but go home with Lot 20, you will still be just as much on track. So don't limit your choices. Conversely, if you fall in love with a particular horse but feel that you are perhaps 'not good enough' to realise its potential, just remember that the horses don't realise that they are ever supposed to be Grand Prix or three-star, and will be just as happy to be fed and watered and loved every day.

Best of luck with this, a first step towards your goal, no matter where it might take you.

DIRECTIONS

An easy 50-minute drive from the Sydney CBD. From Sydney take the M2 Motorway; this continues to become the Westlink M7. Take the Richmond/Blacktown Road exit and continue straight ahead to Richmond. At the intersection of Bourke Street, Blacktown Road becomes Lennox Street. Follow Lennox Street till you get to the intersection with East Market Street; turn right into East Market Street. At the intersection of East Market Street and Windsor Street turn left. This is the main road in Richmond and it turns into Old Kurrajong Road as it leaves town. Follow this road for about 1km, until the sweeping bend with a road on the right, this is Ridges Lane.

Turn right on to Ridges Lane and go straight ahead until you see the sandstone and wrought iron gates to the Sydney Polo Club.

RIDDEN HORSE TRIALLING



This is one of the outstanding opportunities offered through the AOS selling program. We would encourage all riders who are slightly interested in the ridden horses to pluck up the courage to trial these horses in the official trialling times. Of course you are very welcome to trial these horses by prior arrangement in the weeks preceding the auction. Most people do suffer from the thought of riding in front of a crowd on the official trialling day. Our take on this is that if you are too embarrassed to look out for your own interests, then certainly nobody else will. Also, if you have dreams and ambitions, secret or otherwise, and being embarrassed is the biggest obstacle you have to overcome, then really life is not too bad. Realistically you will have to overcome much bigger obstacles than just being self-conscious or embarrassed. Get out there, trial these horses and take advantage of a great opportunity.

At the auction you do have the unique advantage of comparing one horse against the other. This comparison opportunity is exactly what happens in competition, one horse immediately compared against another, a phenomena which is very difficult to replicate when buying a horse privately. Riding is a passion discipline and in most instances when buying privately a prospective purchaser falls in love with a horse and buys it. In the auction situation, a prospective purchaser is much more likely to weigh up the pros and cons of each horse on a comparative basis. Of course, falling in love with the horse is a critical ingredient for success but we at the AOS would encourage you firstly to select your next horse on an intellectual level, then follow your heart and fall in love with the horse. We all know of people that have bought horses that didn't turn out to be everything they had hoped for but nevertheless, love the horse and persevere even when it is clear they should sell and start again. Treat the auction trialling as a day at the office.

We encourage everyone to trial each horse that goes close to falling into their wish list category. Keep in mind that sometimes a horse that reads and looks mediocre in the catalogue actually turns out to be lots better in real life than you had expected. Conversely, some horses will catch your imagination in the catalogue, and then be disappointing in real life. Once you ride more than two horses you will lose track of details on each horse so we encourage you to write notes on each horse immediately after trialling them. Also, watching a horse being trialled by other riders is a great way of assessing honesty and rideability.

The first official trialling is at 2.30pm on Saturday June 29 and we would encourage all interested parties to take advantage of this Saturday trialling. This does give you as the potential buyer the opportunity to have another ride the next day Sunday June 30 at 9.30am. This also gives you enough time to research the horses and talk to the owners.

The basic format of trialling is that two or three horses come into the arena and are shown off for the first five minutes by their vendors, basically warming up and just gently running through the horse's routine. Then people wishing to have a little sit are invited to come forward. Prospective buyers organise to trial a horse by approaching the AOS representative, who takes a list of names so as to keep the trialling ordered, and also signing the appropriate waivers. Each trialling is tailored to each rider's individual needs, keeping in mind that the first and foremost priority is safety, and of course the well-being of the horse. It is a very hectic schedule with two sessions of public trialling plus the auction, all in two days, so horse welfare is a major consideration. We are of course very aware of also servicing the riders' needs.


